Dear Parents of Y3-Y6 pupils,

## **RE: PERMISSION FOR COMPLETING ANTI-BULLYING ALLIANCE WELLBEING QUESTIONNAIRE (Y3-Y6)**

This year, the school is embarking on the 'All Together' anti-bullying programme provided by the Anti-Bullying Alliance (ABA). ABA is a charity that works to reduce bullying in schools and improve the well-being of children. It is based at the National Children's Bureau (NCB).

In order to make sure that we improve the support we offer, we want to find out the current well-being of the pupils in our school. We also want to understand their thoughts and ideas about the strengths and areas for improvement in the behaviour at Ivy Lane. For this reason, we are inviting the Year 3,4,5 and 6 pupils to complete an anonymous survey. We will then ask pupils to complete the questionnaire again in the summer term 2018. Repeating this will help us to measure the positive impact of the changes we make from pupil ideas.

We would therefore like to ask your permission for your child to be invited to complete the survey questionnaire. If you are happy for your child to do this, then you do not have to do anything. If we do not hear from you we will assume you are supportive of your child to being involved. The survey has been specially designed by the Anti-Bullying Alliance for all pupils in Years 3 and above. It is an online survey which should take about 15 minutes to complete. Please be assured that: the answers your child gives to the questionnaire will not be seen by their friends, teachers or you (unless your child chooses an adult to help them complete the questionnaire).

Thank-you for taking the time to read this letter. We look forward to being able to build on the positive wellbeing of the pupils at Ivy Lane, taking their ideas to make the school an even happier place to be.
