Dear Parents,

Re: Year 2 trip to the SS Great Britain on Wednesday 6th February 2019

In term 3, the children will be learning about Isambard Kingdom Brunel. To enhance the children's learning experience we will be visiting the SS Great Britain to enable us to travel back in time to Victorian Britain! We will tackle one of Brunel's challenges by helping to build the SS Great Britain and discover what it was like to attend the launch of the famous ship.

We will be leaving school at 9.30am, travelling by coach. We will have lunch at the SS Great Britain and will aim to return at 2.30pm but most certainly before the end of the school day.

Children will need to wear their **school uniform** on the day and suitable outerwear (i.e. waterproof coat if appropriate). As all KS1 are in receipt of Universal Free School Meals, please let the office know by **Friday 1st February** if you would like the kitchen to provide your child with a packed lunch on the day. If we do not hear from you we will assume that you are providing your child with a healthy packed lunch from home along with a water bottle – thank you.

The voluntary contribution for this trip is £13.60 (reduced for children in receipt of Free School Meals). This amount includes entry to SS Great Britain and the coach costs. Please log onto your SchoolMoney account (schoolmoney.co.uk), choosing SchoolMoney Parent LogIn and using the password in the email/text message sent to give permission for your child to attend this trip and pay the voluntary contribution by **Monday 28th January**. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received, the trip will have to be cancelled.
