## Re: Y6 Junior Good Citizen Programme

Y6 have been invited to take part in the Junior Good Citizen Programme being held on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July at the Scout Headquarters in Potterne at 1.30pm.

Junior Good Citizen Programme is a multi-agency event aimed at equipping young people with the life skills and knowledge to cope in an emergency or a potentially dangerous situation, which could result in them becoming victims of crime and/or sustaining personal injuries. The children will interact with a number of simulated life-like scenarios during the event, which will raise their awareness of the contribution they can make in preventing crime and increasing their own safety. The emphasis is on interaction and children are encouraged to deal with a variety of safety problems such as fire, road safety, anti-social behaviour, home safety and weapons awareness.

The children will be travelling to this event by coach and will leave school at 12 noon and will be returning back to school at a slightly later time of 3.30pm.

Children will need to wear their **uniform** on the day and will need a packed lunch as well as a water bottle. No glass bottles, soft drinks, sweets or chocolate – thank you. If you are in receipt of Free School Meals, please let the school office know as soon as possible if you would like the kitchen to provide your child with a packed lunch on the day.

There is no cost involved in the actual event, however, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £6.00 per child (reduced for children in receipt of Free School Meals) for the cost of the transport. Please log onto your SchoolMoney account ([schoolmoney.co.uk](http://schoolmoney.co.uk)), choosing **SchoolMoney Parent LogIn and using the password in the email/text message sent** to give permission for your child to attend this trip and pay the voluntary contribution by **Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2019**. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received, the trip will have to be cancelled.

I am sure this will prove to be a very interesting and informative afternoon for the children and it will provide them with many different life skills.
