Dear Parents

RE: Year 3 trip to Bath City Farm – Tuesday 24th September 2019

In term 1, the children will be learning about farming, including animals and where our food comes from. To enhance the children's learning experience we will be visiting Bath City Farm on Tuesday 24th September 2019. We will have a tour around the farm as well as meeting the animals.

We will be leaving school at approximately 8.50am, travelling by coach. Amidst our timetable of activities, we will have a packed lunch at the site and will aim to return by 3.00pm.

Children will need to wear their **uniform** on the day along with suitable outdoor footwear, **wellies** are ideal although trainers are suffice. If it is due to be a sunny day, please send your child in wearing **sun cream** and a **sunhat** as we will be outside for the majority of the day, whilst if it ends up being a wet day please ensure they have suitable **waterproof clothing**. They will also need a **packed lunch** as well as a **water bottle**. No glass bottles, soft drinks, sweets or chocolate – thank you. If you are in receipt of Free School Meals, please let the school office know as soon as possible if you would like the kitchen to provide your child with a packed lunch on the day. We would suggest your child uses a **rucksack** for the day as we will not be able to leave our belongings anywhere.

The voluntary contribution for this trip is £8.50 (reduced for children in receipt of Free School Meals). Please log onto your SchoolMoney account (schoolmoney.co.uk), choosing **SchoolMoney Parent Login and using the password in the email/text message sent** to give permission for your child to attend this trip and pay the voluntary contribution by **Tuesday 17th September 2019**. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received, the trip will have to be cancelled.

Finally, we are looking for parent volunteers to accompany us on our trip so if you are available and would like to help, please let one of us know.

We are really looking forward to this exciting experience and our first trip in Year 3!
