

Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) and the Disability Access Fund (DAF)

Payable to your childcare provider

Your childcare provider may be able to access additional funding to support your three or four-year-old.

The EYPP is to improve the overall quality of provision. Payable if your circumstances meet nationally set criteria – similar to Free School Meals and the Two-year-old funding,

The DAF is to support disabled children (in receipt of DLA) access their free entitlements. It's a one-off lump sum paid to the provider nominated by the parent.
