Dear Parents/Carers of current Y2-Y5 children,

## RE: Instrument Lessons

From September 2023, your child will have the chance to learn (or continue to learn) a musical instrument through the school. Learning a musical instrument at an early age offers children terrific opportunities to develop musical skills, improve their confidence by performing in front of others and build social skills by rehearsing and performing as an ensemble. These lessons are currently on offer:

- Piano - individual 20 minute lesson £12
- Guitar (Acoustic or Electric) 20 minutes shared (2/3 learners) £8.00 per session  
20 minutes individual £12 per session
- Drum Kit - 20 minutes 1-2-1 £12 per session
- African drumming - 30 minutes, small group £7 per session

The peripatetic teachers are all self-employed, so the invoices and any communications will come directly from them and not the school.

Lessons are offered on an individual or shared basis, as detailed above, and are usually for 30 weeks of the year. Woodwind instruments are available to hire from the Music Hub.

If your child is registered for Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Funding or Free School Meals (FSM KS2) due to economic circumstances, you may be entitled to a subsidy of up to 70% on lesson fees.

If your child is interested in learning an instrument or continuing with their current lessons, you will need to respond directly to the teacher(s) listed below by **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July**. This deadline is particularly important for those who wish to hire an instrument or receive a subsidy on the cost of lessons.
