This meeting will be an opportunity for you to discuss how your child's current progress. A selection of their learning from across the curriculum will be available outside the classroom for you to look at **before** your appointment. We please ask that you then bring the books into your appointment so they can be referred to as needed by the class teachers.

Appointments will be **strictly 10 minutes long** and teachers will have a timer on their tables to indicate when the meeting time has ended. Please note, our teachers will then stop the meeting at this time and there will not be an opportunity to continue any discussions. This must be adhered to ensure that all appointments run on time and that our teachers are not late home after a long day at school. If you require any further discussion, then please contact your class teacher via the school office.

If you have siblings in school, please allow a **minimum of 10 minutes** between appointments to allow movement around the site and ensure that you are not delayed for your next appointment.

A short guide on how to book appointments is included in this letter. To login, you will need to use your child's name and date of birth as well as your name and email address. If you experience problems booking an appointment, please contact the admin team in the school office and they will check the correct details are being entered.

To ensure that professional discussions can take place with the teacher, we would ask that your child **does not join you in class at the time of the appointment**. We also kindly request that parents/carers ensure any children on site during Parents' Evening do not disturb other meetings taking place, particularly outside the buildings, due to classrooms being adjacent. The KS2 playground is available for car parking from 3.15pm.

Appointments are available to book immediately and the deadline for bookings will be Friday 21st March. Should you wish to make any changes after this date, please contact the school office. **Unless you are part of a split family, please ensure that only one parent/carer books an appointment with the teacher.**

I will be available on both nights, if required.
